Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White scallop panel
- 1 Blue panel with pink
- 1 Blue panel with Yay
- 1 Yellow plane
- 2 Cloud borders
- 1 Die cut goodie bag
- 1 Set foam squares
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need everything except the light blue panel with the Yay, one cloud border, the Large cloud heart and one mini cloud.

1. You'll begin by constructing the airplane first. All of the accent pieces to the airplane are in your goodie bag. Adhere the black wheel and gray propeller first.
2. Next add the wheel cover, nose cone and small angled accent. This piece has a dotted outline for you to follow.
3. Lastly, add the two larger angled accents at the bottom of the plane and the top cover piece. Fit the V shape in between. See example picture for placement help.
4. Adhere the red heart to the white circle and add it to the plane for decoration and your plane is finished.
5. To put everything together, adhere the cloud border to the bottom of the blue panel with a pink edge. The pink should peek over the clouds to look like a sunset. The border will be a little bit long so you will need to trim any excess.
6. Now, use your small heart cloud and two mini clouds to help you choose the position of your plane. Once you have decided, use 3-4 foam squares to adhere your plane to your panel.
7. Add the small heart cloud and two mini clouds onto the card. Trim any excess.
8. To finish out the design, add the three remaining clouds. I let one overhang the left edge and trimmed the excess. Then I used foam squares to adhere the other two clouds in place.
9. Lastly, adhere this decorated panel to the white scallop panel.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the remaining cloud border to the blue panel. Trim any excess.
2. Use the large heart and mini cloud to outline the word Yay. See example picture for placement ideas.
3. Then add the Yay panel to the inside of the white card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
4. Lastly, adhere the front of the card base to the back of the white scallop panel making sure that it is centered and can't be seen from the front of the card. TIP: make sure it opens in the right direction before you adhere it down ;)
