Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Decorative panel
- 1 Tulip set
- 6 Flower stems
- 4 Leaves
- 1 Friend die cut with backer
- Embellishment set
- 1 Foam strip
- Foam squares
- 1 Half decorative panel
- Mailing Liner
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



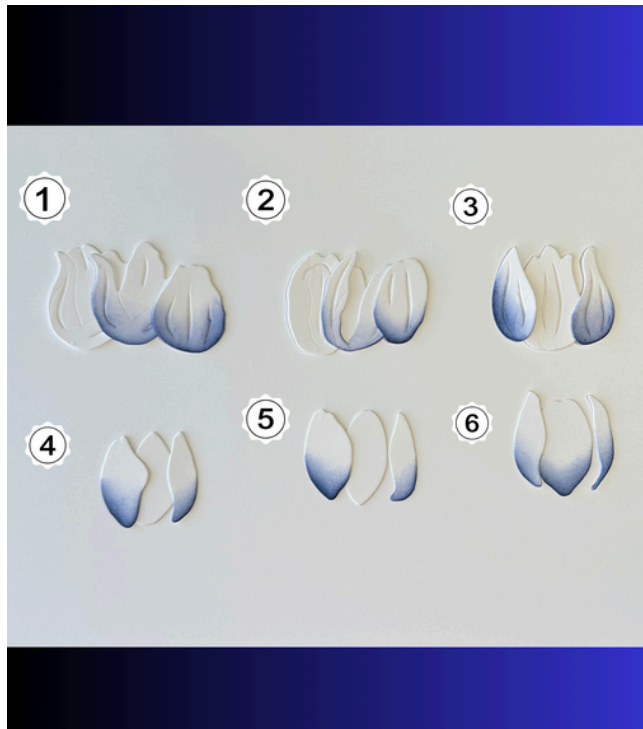
Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need everything except the half stamped panel.

1. You'll begin by constructing the tulips first. Each tulip uses **THREE** white and blue pieces to form the flower. I have labeled them on the back for you. Match the numbers together to create your bloom. Also, I have included a picture to help you. **NOTE:** In the original sample picture I accidentally used two of the same flower. Your card will include all different flowers.
2. Once your flowers are made, loosely lay out the bouquet design on the decorative panel. Include the stems. Take note of how the stem is angled, this may affect your flower. When you have decided on the placement, adhere the flower to the stem. See example picture for placement help. I chose to lean some of the flowers over a little to add interest.
3. Lay out the bouquet again with the stems attached to the flowers. This time add the leaves into the bouquet. There are two left leaning and two right leaning. Choose the placement of the leaves and adhere them to the coordinating stems. I didn't always like where the leaf connected to the stem so I chose to layer things over top of it so that it was hidden.
4. When you have your flowers fully constructed, it is time to adhere them into place on the decorative panel. Lay out the bouquet. Use the three foam squares to pop up the three large blooms for added interest. The other three will be adhered flat to the card. Adhere the bouquet in place. Trim any excess. See example picture for placement help.
5. Adhere the decorated panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along the outside edge.
6. Next, add the white Friend die cut to the blue backer. Don't forget to add the dot of the "i". Then use the foam strip to adhere it to the front of the card. *One side of the foam is adhesive backed, you will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
7. Lastly, using small dots of liquid glue, add the embellishments to the card front for decoration. **NOTE:** my embellishments are different in the example picture. I made a design change when I saw the glue reacted badly to the ink on the decorative panel.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.



1. Adhere the half decorative panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
