Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Green card base
- 1 Green panel
- 1 White panel
- 2 Wreaths
- 1 Red bow
- 2 Green Holly leaves
- 1 Goodie bag- Berries and gold embellishments
- 1 Sentiment
- 1 Foam strip
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except the white panel, holly leaves and 3 holly berries.

1. You will build your card front design on the green panel with the white splatter. When it is finished, you will add it to the card front.
2. Adhere the two wreaths to the green panel layering them together. Do not add adhesive to all areas. This allows some leaves to be lifted and shaped to create interest. Trim the excess.
3. Next, adhere the red bow to the wreath. See example picture.
4. Now, use the red holly berries from the goodie bag to decorate the wreath. NOTE: If you follow my design, you will have 1 berry left when the card is finished.
5. Adhere the decorated panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of green showing along each edge.
6. Using the foam strip, add the sentiment to the card front.
7. Finally, use small dots of liquid glue to decorate the card front with the gold embellishments.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Add the white panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of green showing along each edge.
2. Decorate it with the 2 holly leaves and some holly berries. Note: The holly leaves in the picture are a different color. I changed my mind on the design. I liked the dark green better in the end.
