## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 2 Peach panels- 1 embossed
- 1 Acetate panel- tissue paper backing
- 1 White frame
- 1 Goodie bag-2 Bottles with pieces, glass and wine, flower
- 1 Shaker bits
- 1 Celebrate sentiment
- Foam strips
- Mailing Liner\*\*
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need everything except the plain peach panel, the gold bottle and the flower.

1. You'll begin by creating the shaker "box". To do this, first add the acetate panel to the back of the white frame. You will not need the tissue. I recommend using a strong double sided tape for this, but a liquid glue will also work. Glue will require a longer dry time.
2. Your next step is to put the foam strips onto the back of the white frame panel overtop of the acetate. The foam strips are adhesive backed on both sides. Create a "Foam strip frame" around the cutout. See example picture. This frame will hold all of the shaker goodies so, take care to connect the foam at each corner. This will keep the shaker bits from escaping!
3. To finish the white frame panel, use the wider foam strips to fill in the open space with foam. This will stabilize the card front. The wider foam strips are adhesive backed on only one side. You will need to add adhesive to the remaining side.
4. Once the white frame panel is ready, add liquid glue to the wide foam strips and peel the release paper from the thin strips. Add a light application of liquid glue to the thin foam strips as well. This will allow you to briefly adjust the position of the frame when you put it all together.
5. NOW- add the shaker bits to the inside of the frame. Then place the Embossed peach panel over the white frame panel so that the embossed design is face down. This way it will be showing through the clear front of the card. The white frame panel and the peach panel should align edge to edge. Press along the foam frame to secure it completely before you try the shaker feature. Once the "Shake Box" is secure you should be able to shake it and see the "bubbles" move around.
6. Adhere the shaker box to the front of the card base.
7. Construct the green bottle by decorating it with the gold label and top.
8. Now add the pink glitter to the front of the glass.
9. Use a double sided tape to adhere the green bottle to the front of the card.  
TIP: You can also use glue, it will just take longer to dry.
10. Choosing a small spot behind the pink glitter paper, adhere the glass to the bottle without letting the adhesive show through the vellum paper. TIP: I also used a small dot of glue at the base of the glass and you can see the adhesive... and it still looks completely fine!
11. Next, adhere the Celebrate sentiment to the front of the card.

**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.**



1. Add the plain peach panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
2. Decorate the panel with the gold bottle and flower.
