Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?



First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Colorful panel
- 1 Purple panel
- 1 Butterfly set (2 Wings, 7 Glitter accents)
- 1 Sentiment
- 1 Flower set (4 lg, 8 sm)
- 6 Purple stems
- Foam pieces- adhesive backed on both sides
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

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You'll need everything except the purple panel.

1. You'll begin by layering the flowers. Adhere the small pink and white flowers to the four large white flowers and the two small ones. This will give you six layered flower elements with pink centers.
2. Next, construct the butterfly. To do this, add the glitter elements to the wings where they coordinate. Next, adhere the glitter wingtips to the lower wings and align them at the outside edges. TIP: they are slightly different in size.
3. Once the wings are decorated, adhere them together by adding the bottom wings over the top just a little. See example picture for help. Lastly, adhere the butterfly body in place.
4. You are ready to decorate the card. To begin, adhere the colorful panel to the front of the card base. It will align edge to edge.
5. Next, using the large foam squares, adhere the butterfly to the card front. I chose to tilt mine and place it off center a little. Your placement is up to you!
6. Now, use the purple stems and layered flowers to decorate the front of the card. I chose to keep my elements separate, keeping it somewhat random. Your design is up to you. Trim any excess that hangs off the edge.
7. Lastly, use the narrow foam pieces to add the sentiment to the front of the card. You could also choose to add the sentiment to the inside of the card, but you would want to adhere it flat if you choose that.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Add the purple panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

You did it!
