Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?



First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Large white panel
- 1 Small white panel
- 2 Shirt collar pieces
- 2 Shirt tag pieces
- 5 Stripes
- 1 Flower with peach center
- 1 Happy Birthday sentiment
- 1 Wide white stripe
- Foam squares
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing Liner**



Let's Begin!

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You'll need everything except the smaller white panel, one shirt collar piece and one tag piece.

1. You'll begin by decorating the larger white panel with the shirt pieces. Begin adhering the collar piece at the top of the large white panel. When it is centered at the top there is a small space of white left on each side.
2. Next, choose which tag you'd like to use and adhere it centered inside the collar opening. The remaining tag will be used inside the card.
3. Now it's time to add the thin stripes to the panel. I have included a white paper strip to help you with your spacing. I recommend starting at the bottom and working your way up. Use a light application of glue and clear up any glue squishes as you go. Once the stripes are adhered, trim any excess.
4. Use the adhesive backed foam squares to adhere the Happy Birthday to the panel. See example picture for placement ideas. The foam squares can be trimmed with scissors as needed.
5. Adhere the peach circle to the center of the flower. Then add the flower to the decorated panel. See example picture.
6. Lastly, adhere the panel to the front of the card base. It will fit edge to edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the remaining collar piece to the top of the smaller white panel. It will hang over just slightly. See example picture.
2. Next, add the remaining tag piece to the collar opening.
3. Lastly, adhere this decorated panel to the inside of the card leaving a white border showing along each edge.



You did it!
