Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White panel
- 1 cloud panel
- 2 Blue accordion panel
- 1 Red frame
- 1 Grass
- 2 White clotheslines
- 3 Clouds
- 2 Tall green socks
- 1 Goodie bag (socks w/accents)
- 2 Sentiments
- Foam squares
- Mailing Liner**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



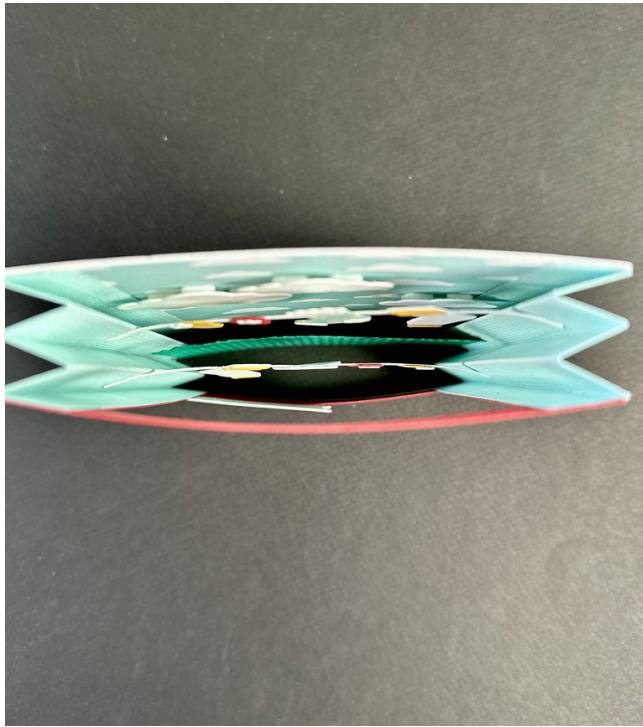
Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need everything except the white panel and the tall green socks.

1. Begin by folding the blue accordion panels back and forth along the scored lines. See example picture.
2. Next, you will adhere the accordion panels to the cloud paper. The smooth side of the folded panels will be seen from the outside and the textured side will be seen from the inside. Adhere the blue panels along the edge of the cloud paper so that the free edge is toward the inside and the folded edge is along the outside. See example picture.
3. Before you move on, take a moment to decorate the cloud panel with the cloud die cuts. Use the foam squares to adhere them to the cloud panel.
4. Now that the background is ready and both accordion panels have been added, adhere the red frame to the top of the accordion pieces. I recommend that you adhere only one side of the red frame at a time. Do not add adhesive along the top and bottom of the frame.
5. Now you have constructed your
6. pop-up card base. You can press the whole card flat to fit in the envelope! Next, you will decorate your socks.
7. In the goodie bag you will find the socks and their accents. Add the white ruffle, heel accent and toe accent to the daisy socks.
8. Add the yellow stripes and toe accent to the white socks.
9. Add the star and flower accents to the small socks.
10. Now it's time to add the Clotheslines without the socks. The accordion folds create three "V" openings on the left and right side of the card where you will build your scene. Decide your position and angle of the back clothesline, then adhere one end of the background clothesline to the middle "V" opening. See example picture. Finish installing the background clothesline by adhering the other end of the clothesline to the opposite side. Trim the clothesline if necessary.
11. Adhere One of each sock onto the back clothesline. Take care that you don't accidentally glue them to the cloud panel! TIP: If you are making this a baby card, you may want to edit which socks go onto the clothesline. The design is completely up to you!
12. Next, repeat step 9 and 10 with the second clothesline. This time you will adhere it to the front "V" opening. See example picture for placement ideas.
13. Now, add glue to the ends of the grass piece. Slide the grass along the center "V" opening until it aligns with the bottom edge. Then press the glued edges in place to secure it to the accordion fold. Trim if necessary.
14. Lastly, adhere your preferred sentiment to the front of the card and trim any excess.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.



1. Add the white panel to the back of the card. It should fit edge to edge.
2. Next, adhere the tall green socks to the panel for added decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.
